APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- U.S. citizen and Walton County, Florida resident (student or parent/legal guardian).
- Currently enrolled or have been accepted at a college, university or technical school and majoring in botany, ecology, horticulture, forestry, landscape design or architecture, agriculture, environmental studies, biology, or an acceptable related degree.
- If the applicant is currently enrolled, he/she must have a “C+” average (2.5) or higher.
- Scholarship funds will be sent directly to the college, university, or technical school as part of a tuition payment.

The Green Thumb Garden Club, Inc., located in Walton County, Florida, is a tax-exempt, 501(c)(3) non-profit organization. GTGC supports other non-profit organizations in the community including, but not limited to, educational institutions, youth groups and environmental preservation.

The GTGC’s **purpose** is to stimulate interest in the beautification of Walton County, to further the education of its members and the public in the fields of gardening, horticulture, botany, floral design, environmental awareness, conservation of natural resources, civic beautification, and nature studies. It is our goal to instill in our youth and young adults the love of gardening and respect for the environment.
